

## FRANKLIN COUNTY 4-H HORSE PROJECTS

### A Guide for Club Advisors

- ✿ **Horse ID Forms** are due to the Extension Office by **April 1, 2021**.
- ✿ All 4-H members taking a horse project must complete and submit a **Horse Permission to Participate Form** by **April 1, 2021**.
- ✿ Members taking a horse project for the first time must:
  - Purchase and read the book **191R Horse Safety, and You**
  - Attend one of the **Horse Safety & Ethics** sessions with a parent or legal guardian.
    - April 13, 6:30pm, Extension Office
    - May 10, 6:30pm, Extension Office
- ✿ Any member leasing their horse must submit a copy of the **horse lease** with the Horse ID Form by **April 1, 2021**.
- ✿ All clubs that have members taking 4-H horse projects (*does not include Horseless Horse*) should send a club advisor to represent the club at **4-H Horse Advisory Committee** meetings.
  - Meetings begin at 7:00pm, at the Franklin County Fairgrounds.
    - February 1
    - March 1
    - April 5
    - May 3
    - June 7
    - July 5
    - October 4
    - November 1
  - Much of the information needed to be properly prepared for judging and fair events is shared at these meetings.
  - In order to maintain the number of events available for horse members to participate in, volunteer help is needed to run the events. Franklin County horse events are planned by this committee.
