The topic of the essay:

- All essays should be typed and single spaced. They should be one full page in length, with font - Times new roman size 14.
- Each essay should have a title and list your name. Essay must follow the Rubric attached in support of this topic question.
- You are responsible for printing a copy of your essay and displaying in on a Horse Royalty board on your stall at fair by 8AM 1st day of fair.

Horse Royalty Board Requirements for County Fair

- Board must be 18”x 24 “ in size. (this is standard bulletin board size)
- Board must include the words “Horse Royalty Candidate 2023”
- Board must display a copy of the essay submitted for grading
- You should include pictures and information about you and your horse.
- It may be framed but does not not have to be.
- Board must be hung on your stall by 8AM on first day of fair.
