






New 4-H Club/Affiliate Financial Guidance

- 990N e-Postcard filed before May 15 by 4-H professionals
- Checking accounts need two signatures on each check
- Bank statements should be sent to a non-check signer for club & Extension office for committees.
- Budget to be created & approved by a vote each year
- Audit AT LEAST every three years

- Receipts should be provided when money is received for anything
- Deposit funds within a week from receipt
- Debit/credit card are not the preferred method, but are permitted, as long as expenses are pre-approved, itemized receipts provided, and data is properly recorded in ledger.


