## Help 4-H Youth - Interested in Purchasing an Animal for the Meat.

To help the youth market their animals, we are looking for individuals or a group of individuals that are interested in purchasing the meat for their own consumption. The list will be created on a first come first served basis. Please note, some species have a limited number of animals we can sell for the meat.

You will be contacted if we have an animal available for you to purchase. Actual market value will be provided during that call.

Market-ready animals that can be purchased for the meat are listed below.

Steers      Hogs      Lambs (2)      Chickens      Ducks      Geese      Turkeys

### How do I add my name to the list?

If you are interested in adding your name to the list to purchase the animals for the meat or if you would like to purchase the meat for donation to the Mid-Ohio Food Collective, please let us know when you register. (The Food Collective can only accept donations of Beef or Swine.)

### What is my responsibility if I want to purchase the meat?

By adding your name to the list and purchasing the meat, you are responsible to pay the Fr Co Livestock Sale Committee the market value of the animal. (Market value is the market price per pound multiplied by the weight of the animal.) You will **also** be responsible to pay the butcher for packaging and pick up of the meat.

**Example:** Market value (220lb hog x .55 per lb) \$110.00

**PLUS** you will pay the butcher separately for the packaging at time of the meat pickup.

**Donate the Meat to the Mid-Ohio Food Collective** – You can choose to donate the meat to the Mid-Ohio Food Collective. The buyer is responsible for the market value. (Market value is the market price per pound multiplied by the weight of the animal.) The Food Collective will mail the buyer a tax-deductible receipt for the market value of the animal. The Mid-Ohio Food Collective will pay the butcher for packaging and pick up of the meat.

**Example:** Market value (220lb hog x .55 per lb) \$110.00 = You pay \$110.00

The Mid-Ohio Food Collective will pay the butcher for the packaging of the meat. You support your community by helping the local food bank.
