

4-H CAMP OHIO GUIDELINES

1. The 4-H Camp Ohio health center is available to all participants and has routine first-aid and emergency supplies. All injuries are to be reported to the camp nurse immediately.
2. 4-H Camp Ohio discourages bringing valuable personal equipment to camp. 4-H Camp Ohio is not liable if such equipment is lost, broken or stolen.
3. Only firearms needed for program purposes and which are kept under lock when not in use are permissible.
4. All visitors must check in with the Camp Director upon arrival.
5. Campers are not permitted to leave camp at any time without the consent of the Camp Director and parent or legal guardian. Campers must check-in and check-out at the nurse's station.
6. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and fireworks are prohibited.
7. Fires must be built ONLY in designated areas with approval of the 4-H Camp Ohio management and supervised at all times.
8. Flammable liquids and explosives are prohibited from being brought to camp.
9. Hand and power tools may be brought to camp ONLY with the prior knowledge and consent of the 4-H Camp Ohio Executive Director. These items must be closely supervised and safely stored.
10. All shooting sports require an instructor who has certification to teach.
11. Smoking is NOT permitted.
12. Campers and visitors are not allowed on the car bridge at any time. This is not a program or recreation area. Please use the footbridge instead.
13. Wading in the stream when not engaged in supervised study is prohibited.
14. **Shoes must be worn at all times except when swimming, showering or sleeping. Flip-flops may only be worn to and from the pool and the restrooms.**
15. **Proper attire is to be worn at all meals - - no tank tops, halter tops or swim suits. Hats should be taken off upon entering the dining hall.**
16. No one but 4-H Camp Ohio staff is permitted behind the serving counter in the kitchen or in staff housing at any time.
17. Boys are prohibited from entering the girls' cabin areas; girls are prohibited from entering the boys' cabin areas.
18. Writing on buildings and walls is prohibited. Any posters, lists, etc. to be put on the walls in buildings must be attached with tape - - **NO STAPLES, NAILS, ETC. \$25.00 fine per incidence**
19. Water balloon and shaving cream fights are prohibited in or around buildings. These activities should take place on the activities field and MUST be cleaned up immediately afterwards.
20. Teasing and handling of the animals in the nature center and shelter is prohibited.
21. No crafts will be allowed to be done in the dining hall.
22. Sledding of any kind is prohibited.
23. Swim ONLY with the supervision of a lifeguard. Swimming in the pond is prohibited.
24. Football playing is prohibited because it is not covered by insurance.
25. Ball playing is prohibited in the Recreation Hall, Dining Hall and Multi-Purpose Building. Also, the Multi-Purpose room is not designed for active recreation or dancing.
26. **No youth participants will be permitted to have a cell phone in their possession during camp. Any cell phones found at camp that have not been checked in with adult staff will be grounds for dismissal from camp.**
