

Butterfly Snack Bag

Franklin County 4-H Camp in a Box Activity Guide

Activity Objectives:

Participants will –

- Make a fun snack.
- Create a butterfly craft.

Time: 15 minutes

Supplies:

- Zip top snack bag
- Clothespin
- Marker or Colored Pencils
- Pipe cleaner
- Googly eyes
- Mixing bowl
- Small snacks like fish crackers, pretzels, cereal, popcorn, chocolate candies, dried fruit, etc.

WHAT TO DO

1. Decorate the clothespin with markers or colored pencils. If you have the supplies, you could also paint the clothespin but make sure the paint dries before moving to the next step.
2. Attach the googly eyes towards the end of the clothespin that opens. Set the clothespin aside.
3. In the mixing bowl, combine selected snacks and lightly stir them together to create the desired trail mix.
4. Put the trail mix into the snack bag and seal the zip top.
5. Use your fingers to cinch the middle of the bag pulling together the top and bottom. Then clip it with the clothespin.
6. Cut the pipe cleaner in half. Set one half of the pipe cleaner out of the way. On the other half, curl/roll down both tips. Then fold it in half.
7. Clip the folded center of the pipe cleaner into the clothespin with the bag. Enjoy!



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
