Franklin County Project Completion Requirements

1. Completed Project Book.
2. An educational display is required for the You and Your Dog Project.
3. Be prepared to discuss your project experiences.

- ✿ **Acceptable clothing** for all Obedience classes, including Rally, includes slacks, dressy shorts, skorts, capris or crop pants, colored dress jeans, collared blouses and shirts, polo shirts, or similar attire, closed-toe shoes, rubber-soled shoes, flats, and similar type footwear.
- ✿ **Acceptable clothing** for girls in Showmanship classes are dresses, skirts, dress shorts, skirts, dress slacks, dressy Capri or crop pants, collared blouses, or similar attire. Acceptable clothing for boys includes dress shirts, ties, and dress slacks. Sports jackets may be worn, but are not necessary, especially in hot weather. When wearing a tie, secure it with a tie tack. Closed-toe shoes, rubber-soled shoes, flats, and similar types of shoes are acceptable footwear. Club shirts, jeans, and shorts are acceptable for Agility.

- ✿ Member must participate in a Project Interview during the Franklin County Fair, on the appropriate day, to be eligible to be considered for Ohio State Fair Selection.
- ✿ Member must display a representation of their project in their 4-H club fair booth.

Franklin County Project Completion Requirements

1. At least 7 Activities
 2. At least 2 learning experiences.
 3. Completed Project Review and attached Feed Tag.
 4. An educational display on a topic from the project book.
 5. Be prepared to discuss your project experiences.
- ✿ Cats being brought to evaluations must be kept in a cat carrier when they are not being evaluated.
 - ✿ Cats must be at least 15 weeks of age at the time of the county evaluations.
 - ✿ Must bring a completed County Companion Animal Day Certification of Vaccination for Cats & Ferrets to Evaluation Check-In. http://www.ohio4h.org/~prec/4h/sm_animal/index.htm
 - ✿ The cat must be owned by the member or an immediate family member. Member should be involved in the continual care (feeding, cleaning, etc.) for the cat for the duration of the project.

- ✿ Member must display a representation of their project in their 4-H club fair booth.

Franklin County Project Completion Requirements

1. At least 8 Activities
2. At least 2 learning experiences.
3. At least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
4. Completed Topic of Interest Summary and attached Feed Tag.
5. An educational display on a topic from the project book.
6. Be prepared to discuss your project experiences.

The rabbit is not required to come to the fair due to possible heat stress on the animal. The decision to bring the animal to the evaluation at the fair is left to the owner. No points will be deducted for not having the animal present
