Selection & Enrollment

November - March



1. Review [Franklin County 4-H project requirement guide\(s\)](#)
2. Present a project demonstration at a club meeting.
3. Find the project evaluation date in the [Franklin County 4-H and Junior Fair Calendar](#).
4. Thoroughly read and complete all the requirements listed in the front of project book.
5. Prepare a project display to present during an interview evaluation.

Project Requirements

January - July



1. Review [Franklin County Junior Fair Book](#).
2. Complete the [Fair Entry](#) process by the June deadline.
3. Explore the Pre-Fair Packet shared in the Green & Growing Newsletter at the end of June for important details about project evaluation reservations.
4. Sign-up for a project evaluation time slot according to the instructions in the Pre-Fair Packet.

Fair Entries & Appointment

May - June



1. Follow email instructions to secure electronic Junior Fair Pass.
2. Plan to display project in 4-H club booth during the Franklin County Fair.
3. Arrive 15 minutes prior to evaluation appointment.
4. Sign - in for project evaluation at the check - in table.
5. Complete interview with project evaluation judge.
6. Stay for awards ceremony following evaluations (excluding livestock and horse projects).
