

Cluck Cluck Chicken Cup Noise Maker

Franklin County 4-H Camp in a Box Activity Guide

Activity Objectives:

Participants will –

- Create a noise maker

Time: 15 minutes

Supplies:

- Plastic cup (with a small hole in the bottom)
- String or yarn – 24” long
- Tape
- Googly eyes
- Construction paper
- Feathers
- Small piece of sponge

WHAT TO DO

1. Tie a knot at the end of the string. Send the untied end of the string through the hole in the cup and pull it through until the knot stops at the bottom of the cup. Use some tape to secure the knot to the cup so it doesn't get pulled through.
2. Place the cup on the table upside down.
3. Decorate the cup to look like a chicken. Tape feathers at the top. Attach googly eyes. Cut the construction paper in the shape of a diamond, fold in half, then tape to the cup as a beak.
4. Attach the small sponge to the end of the string by creating a hole in the sponge and guiding the string through the hole. Then tie the string to the sponge to secure it.
5. Lightly moisten the sponge then squeeze excess water out.
6. To make noise, hold the chicken cup in one hand and the sponge in the other hand. Wrap the sponge around the string up towards the cup. While tightly squeezing the sponge around the string, make quick jerking motions pulling the sponge down the string. Keep practicing until your chicken is clucking away!



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
