

# Clover Pipe Cleaner Craft

## Franklin County 4-H Camp in a Box Activity Guide

### Activity Objectives:

Participants will –

- Create a clover shape out of a pipe cleaner.

**Time:** 5 minutes

### Supplies:


- 1 green pipe cleaner

### WHAT TO DO

1. Place your first four fingers starting with your thumb together in a square-like shape and place the pipe cleaner in the middle of the top two and bottom two fingers.
2. Twist the pipe cleaner around your thumb, then ring finger.
3. Twist it up around your middle finger and then your index finger with the pipe cleaner ending in the middle.
4. Twist the pipe cleaner around the middle of the clover left to right and then around the middle again bottom to top, then continue to wrap the pipe cleaner around so that the stem is at the bottom of the clover.
5. Finally, you can gently slip the clover off of your fingers and using your nail push down slightly so that the leaf is a heart like shape similar to the 4-H clover.

# Lollipop Pipe Cleaner Craft

### Activity Objectives:

Participants will –

- Create a lollipop shape out of pipe cleaners.

**Time:** 5 minutes

### Supplies:

- 2 fun colored pipe cleaners
- 1 white, brown or black pipe cleaner
- Scissors
- Glue

### WHAT TO DO

1. Select 2 bright colors and twist them onto each other so they are swirled.
2. Roll the swirled pipe cleaners onto themselves so they form a tight circle. Use some glue on the end of the pipe cleaners to secure them into place.
3. Use scissors to cut the pipe cleaner that you are going to use for the stick about  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the way down.
4. Put a small amount of glue on the top of the short portion of your stick pipe cleaner and then place it onto the back of the lollipop.
