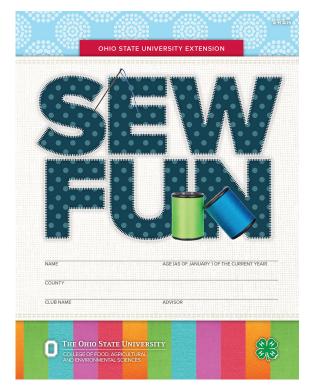

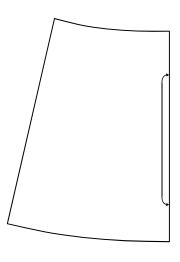
## Simple Skirt Pattern

#### **SUGGESTED FABRICS**

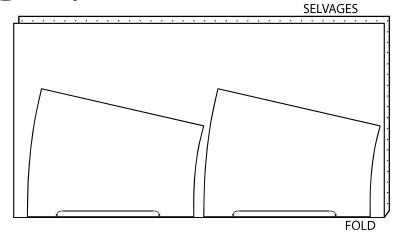
Lightweight to medium weight woven fabrics: cotton types, batiks, calico, chambray, chintz, cotton lawn, gingham, seersucker. Allow extra fabric for matching plaids or stripes.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

Thread, 7/8" yard of 3/4" wide elastic.

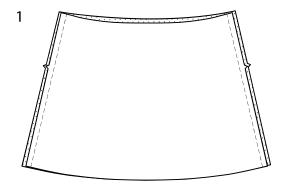

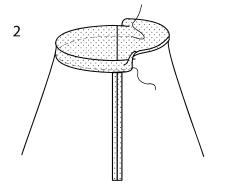
## **Sewing Directions**

Fabric Key

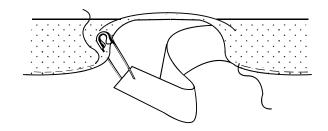
Right Side Wrong Side Stitch 5/8" seams unless otherwise stated. Finish all seams with an approved seam finish - see Seam Finishes Guide for approved seam allowance finishes.



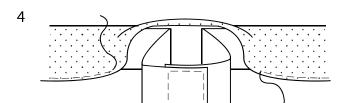
With RIGHT sides together, stitch front and back skirt together at side seams. Finish seam edges.



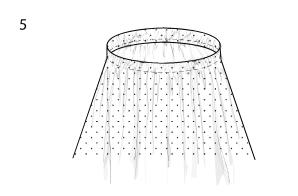
Create channel for elastic by folding top edge of skirt down twice. First 1/4", then 1". Edgestitch along lower folded edge leaving 2" unsewn at center back to feed elastic through.



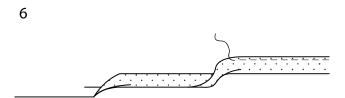
Cut a piece of elastic to fit your waist plus 1". Attach a safety pin to each end of the elastic. Attach one safety pin to waistband channel and feed the other through the channel, making sure elastic does not flip.



Overlap elastic ends by 1" and sew a box.



Pull elastic fully inside channel and close channel. Distribute fullness around waistband evenly. \*Tip: To prevent elastic from flipping while wearing, stitch through all thicknesses of waistband in the groove of each seam.



Press up hem allowance on skirt twice, first 1/4" then 5/8".

Stitch to hold hem in place.
